Introduction

Start with showing the video of a brief talk on careers: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xB2vZTQlusg

Discuss the importance of having dreams and aspirations for the future and that thinking of a career now allows one to reach their goals. Share your presentation of your dream career and allow students to ask you questions.

Students will have a set deadline to complete their presentation and deliver it to the class. When students present to their classmates, we will allow time for a short Q & A after the presentation.

Student Activities

- Learning opportunities within this lesson allow the students to pick an interesting career choice, research their career, then present their findings to the class.
- Extension: Finding the opportunity for each student to meet with a person in their field of interest to ask questions and understand the job.

Student Assessment

Students will be able to present to their classmates about the career they hope to pursue. Their classmates will provide feedback on what they have learned or enjoyed from their presentation.
