Introduction

How are you going to obtain the students' attention and redirect them toward the lesson topic?

As students enter, the Barbie Careers Sing-Along Video at <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ujdW83O1ffE> can be playing to build anticipation for the theme. An optional shelf display or bulletin board can highlight the interesting careers of Barbie and Ken. Even a Barbie airplane could potentially be displayed if available to borrow. Many pilot Barbie dolls and one pilot Ken doll are available at thrift stores, or you can borrow them. If possible, display many Barbie careers books and other career-themed books; a whole series of Barbie career books can be ordered from interlibrary loan prior to the unit. Students can browse books for checkout as they walk in. Alternatively, students can settle in and color a Barbie careers page quietly as remaining students browse books and enter.

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Materials to be presented</i> <p>Once students have settled into a spot where they can view both the reader and the video screen, choose to turn off the Barbie Careers Sing-Along video at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ujdW83O1ffE or choose to allow students to watch the remainder. This is a long music video that displays careers with karaoke captions.</p> <p>Have students communicate one career from the sing-along video that interests them, one by one. Record students' completion on the evaluation checklist.</p> <p>Read aloud the pilot story from the book called <i>Barbie: You Can Be Anything 5-Minute Stories</i> (ISBN 978-1683432043).</p> <p>As you read, discuss the various terminology from the pilot career.</p> <p>Watch the HirePaths videos featuring pilots at https://hirepaths.com/cool-careers-videos/pilot and https://hirepaths.com/cool-careers-videos/drone-pilot. Record activity on the evaluation checklist while students are engaged.</p> <p>After the video, have students ask a question about the content. Record participation on the evaluation checklist.</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>Demonstration points</i> <p>HirePaths resources can help students explore a variety of careers.</p> <p>Barbie has held more than 250 careers.</p> <p>The HirePaths pilot videos contain some interesting words that we can discuss (teachers may pick the words that fit with students' needs and levels):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pilot ● Aviation ● Air Patrol ● Private Jet ● Medical Pilot ● Airline ● Hangar ● Co-Pilot ● Simulator ● Drone ● Remote Control ● Surveyor ● 3D Model ● Pilot License |

Summative assessment could occur when teachers evaluate the optional career word search or record book checkouts.





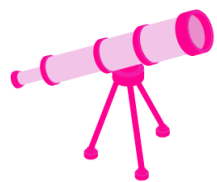
