## **Assignments**

Before this lesson, share the following HirePaths blog with the class that discusses the paths students can take after high school:

Instruct students to read the above blog post in advance of the next class period. This could be assigned as homework or using the last 10 minutes of a prior class period. This blog could also be emailed to parents/guardians to introduce the upcoming lesson and encourage them to discuss options after high school with their students.

#### Introduction

## **Bell Ringer:**

Have students answer the following prompts: Real Success Stories Padlet

## Prompts:

- 1) What job/career do your parents/guardians presently have?
- 2) Do you know the training/education they received after high school?

After students have finished answering the questions on the Padlet, review responses as a class, spending time to discuss answers. Share with the class your career path, the education/training you received after high school, etc.

#### **Directions:**

Instruct students that they will be completing research using the HirePaths website, preparing a presentation, and sharing their findings with the class.

# **Summary**

Discuss with students that there are many paths to take after high school, many of which do not require a four-year degree. It is important to begin researching the training/education needed to obtain the type of career they are interested in pursuing.

### **Student Assessment**

Direct students to provide a response for prompt #3 in the Real Success Stories Padlet: How has this research changed the way you think about your future career, in particular?
